



VILLAGE OF ORCHARD PARK RECYCLING AND REFUSE GUIDELINES June 2017

Dear Village of Orchard Park Residents.

Waste Management is very pleased to continue as the Village of Orchard Park's contracted hauler of solid waste and recyclables. We hope that this informational letter and recycling collection schedule will be helpful in answering any questions you may have, most specifically the changes regarding Trash Carts beginning June 1, 2017.

Service Day

All households in the Village will continue to have their garbage serviced on Friday. Recycling will be collected on ***alternating*** Fridays. Please refer to the street guide on the flip-side of this letter to see which week your recycling will be collected.

Garbage or Yard Waste

Beginning June 1, 2017 Trash Carts provided by the Village must be used to contain solid waste for collection. The Trash Cart should be placed within 5 feet of the curb or roadside by 6:30am on your collection day, with the front of the cart facing the road. Residents may purchase stickers for extra containers outside of the Trash Cart (a maximum of 60 pounds or 40 gallons in volume is allowable for each bag or container) at the Village Office, 4295 South Buffalo St. Waste Management will not collect extra bags/containers outside of the Trash Cart that are not stickered.

Bulky Waste and White Goods (Appliances)

Waste Management will collect (2) bulky items or white goods (appliances) on the first collection day of each month. ***White goods will be collected separately from your household waste and/or recycling. Residents are responsible for the licensed removal and disposal of all refrigerant from applicable white goods.*** Residents may purchase stickers for extra bulky or white goods at the Village Office, 4295 South Buffalo St. Waste Management will not collect extra bulky items or white goods over the monthly limit of (2) that are not stickered.

- ✓ Plasterboard, scrap wood etc must also be less than 4 foot in length and not to exceed 60 pounds and must be bundled or containerized.
- ✓ Carpeting must be rolled in 4 foot or less lengths and taped securely. Rolls should not exceed 60 pounds.
- ✓ Tires will not be accepted.
- ✓ No contractor materials will be collected.

Recycling

Recycling must be placed in Village provided recycling container or similar containment method.
