

Dear Resident:

The Village of Orchard Park will be supplying 96 gallon Trash Carts to properties classed as a 1, 2, or 3 family home. The carts will be delivered May 15-16, 2017. They are similar to the Recycling Carts that were rolled out in 2014, but the Trash Carts have a gray lid stamped with the words "Trash Only".

The Trash Cart can be used for trash collection immediately, but must be used beginning June 1, 2017, when the Village begins a new contract with Waste Management. The following is a brief outline of guidelines that will begin June 2017; additional information is available on the Village website:

- One 96 gallon cart (provided by the Village of Orchard Park) of solid waste will be collected weekly.
  - Additional bags or cans of trash (not exceeding 60 pounds in weight or 40 gallons in volume each) placed outside of the cart will be collected if a tag is attached. Tags can be purchased in the Village Office.
- The first collection of the month, two (2) additional Bulky Waste or White Goods will be collected. The owner or occupant of the dwelling unit is responsible for the licensed removal and disposal of all refrigerant from applicable White Goods.
  - Extra Bulky Waste or White Goods will be collected if a tag is attached. Tags can be purchased in the Village Office.
- Solid waste can be bagged or placed loosely inside of the Trash Cart.
- No item exceeding 4 foot in length should be placed in the cart.
- Recycling will continue to be collected bi-weekly. The Recycle Cart is gray with a burgundy colored lid that is stamped with the words "Recyclables Only, No Trash...".
- The Carts are the property of the Village and should remain with the property if the property is sold. Carts are tracked by the ID number stamped on the cart.
- One Trash Cart will generate an annual fee for collection and disposal.

There is a public meeting scheduled for May 8, 2017 at 6:30 p.m. in the Municipal Building at 4295 South Buffalo Street. There will be representatives present from the Village Board and Waste Management to provide information and to answer questions; and a Trash Cart will be available to view.
